One tool that we have, is to see if they are in violation of **626.9 PC**, SUMMARY: Any person who possesses a firearm, whether loaded or unloaded, in or on the grounds of a public or private school for kindergarten to grade 12, or within **1000 feet of the school**, without written permission of the proper school authority or on the grounds of a public university or college. It is a wobbler and the circumstances dictate either a felony or misdemeanor arrest.

Dispatch has a mapping program called "MAVERICK MAPS" that has a scale on it. They can place your location on the map then go out 1000' and determine if you're within a school zone. Remember that it is not the center point of the school, it is 1000' from the perimeter of the school grounds. So a large campus like Fremont High School has a 1000' area from around its entire perimeter.
